

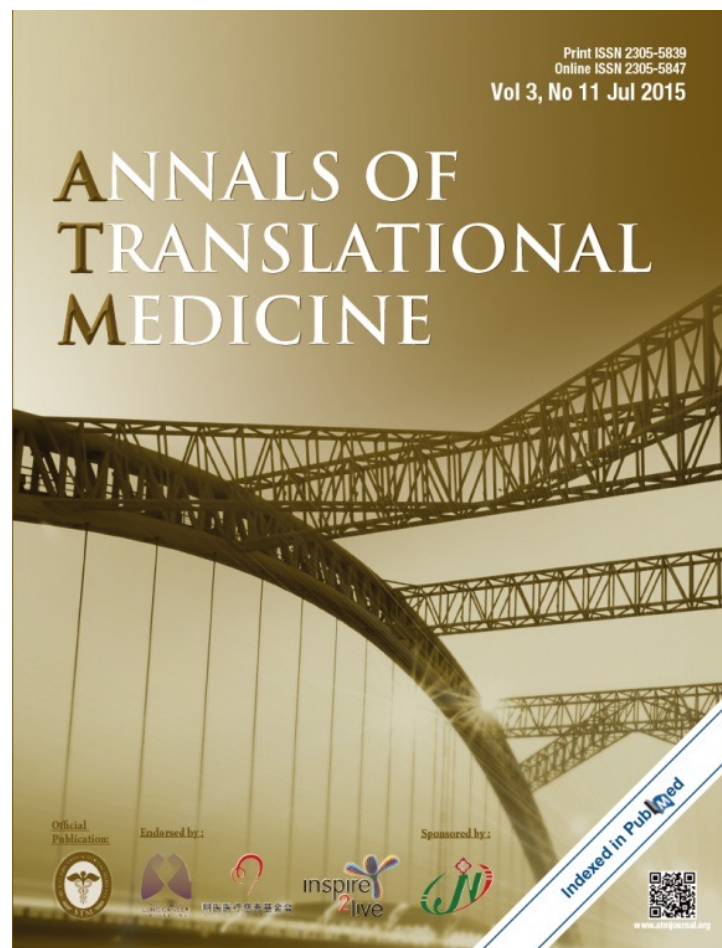

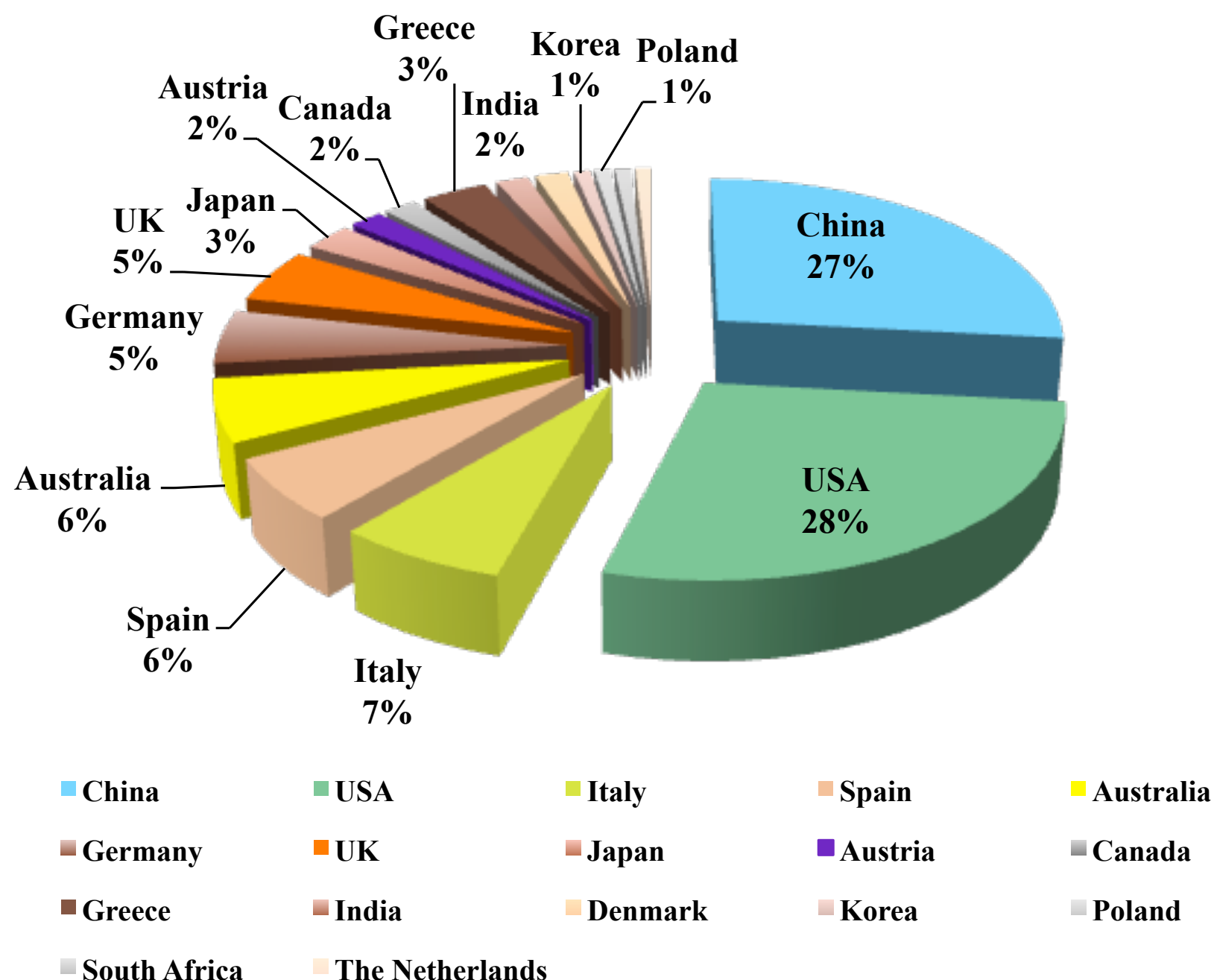

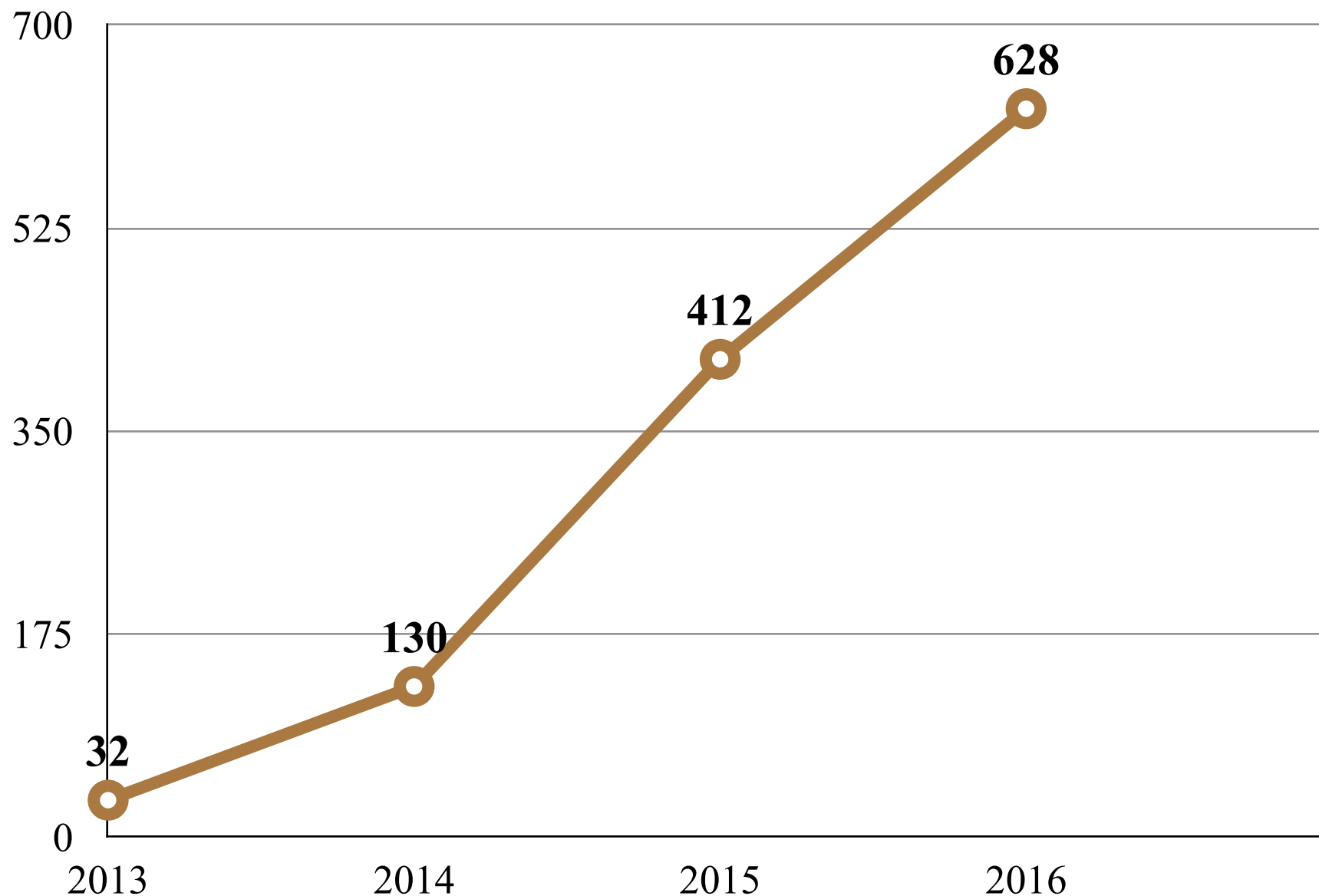

4. Number of Published Articles (results by year)

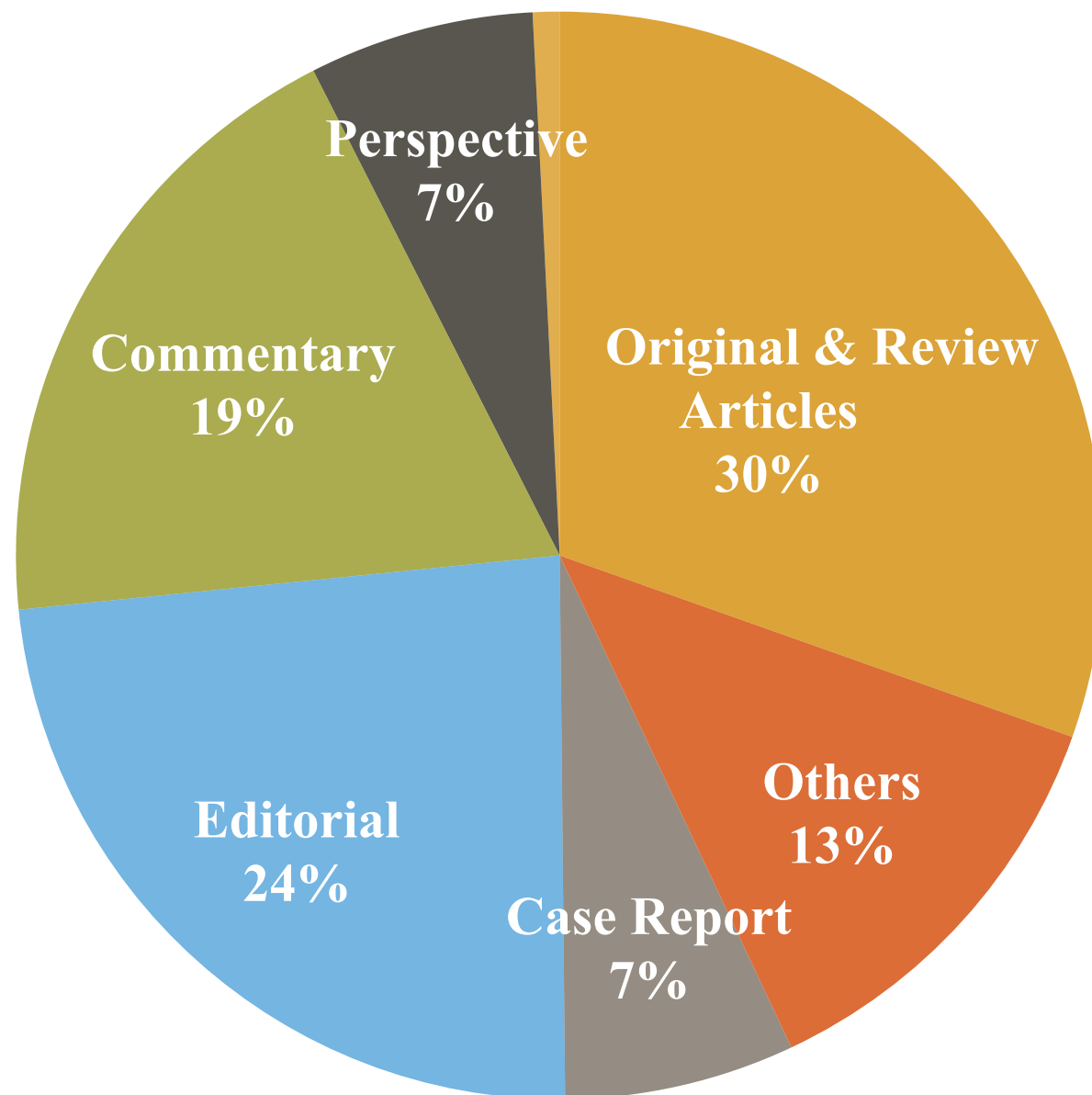


628 articles published in 2016.

Number of articles has been increasing rapidly by year.

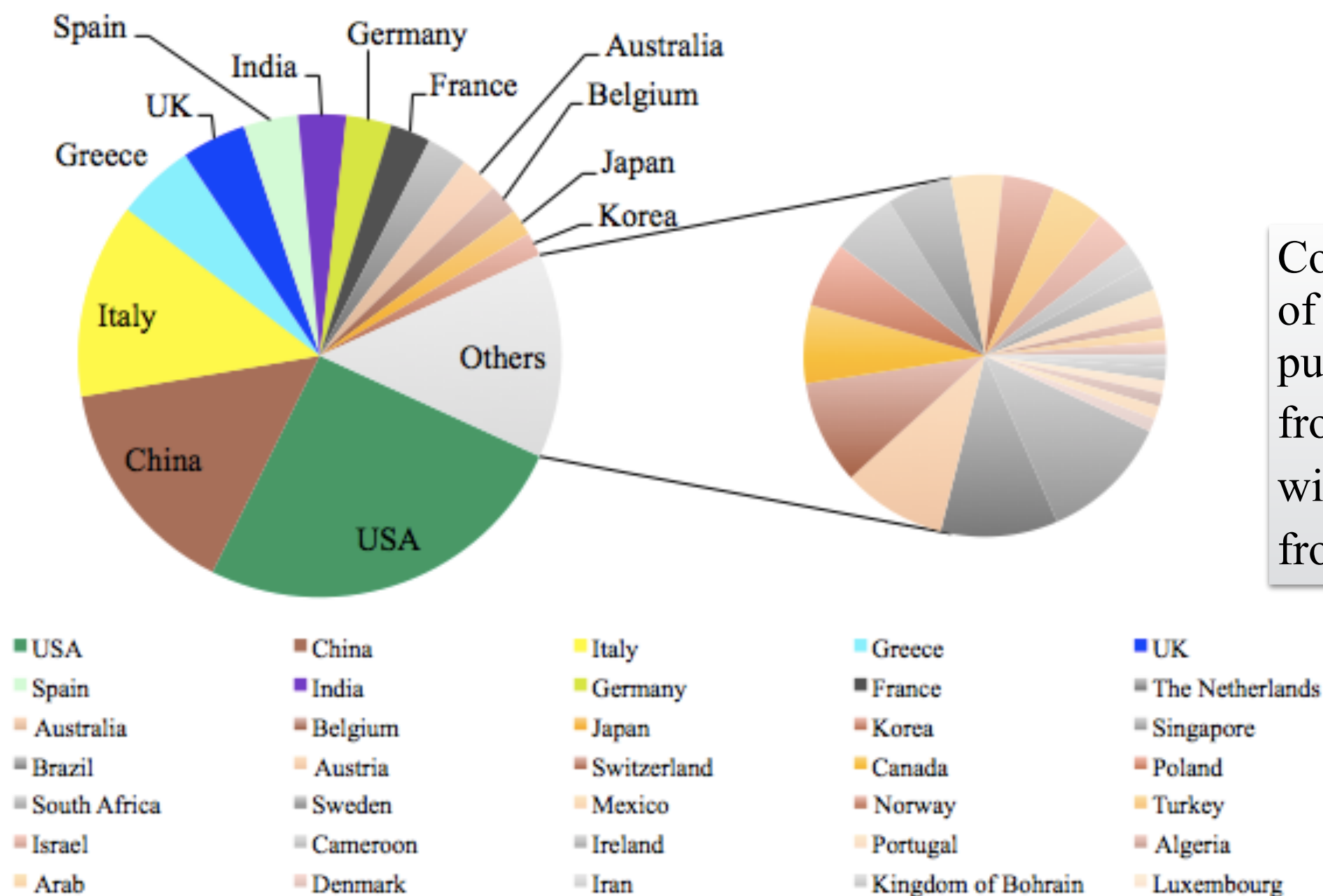

5. Diverse Types of Article Published in 2016



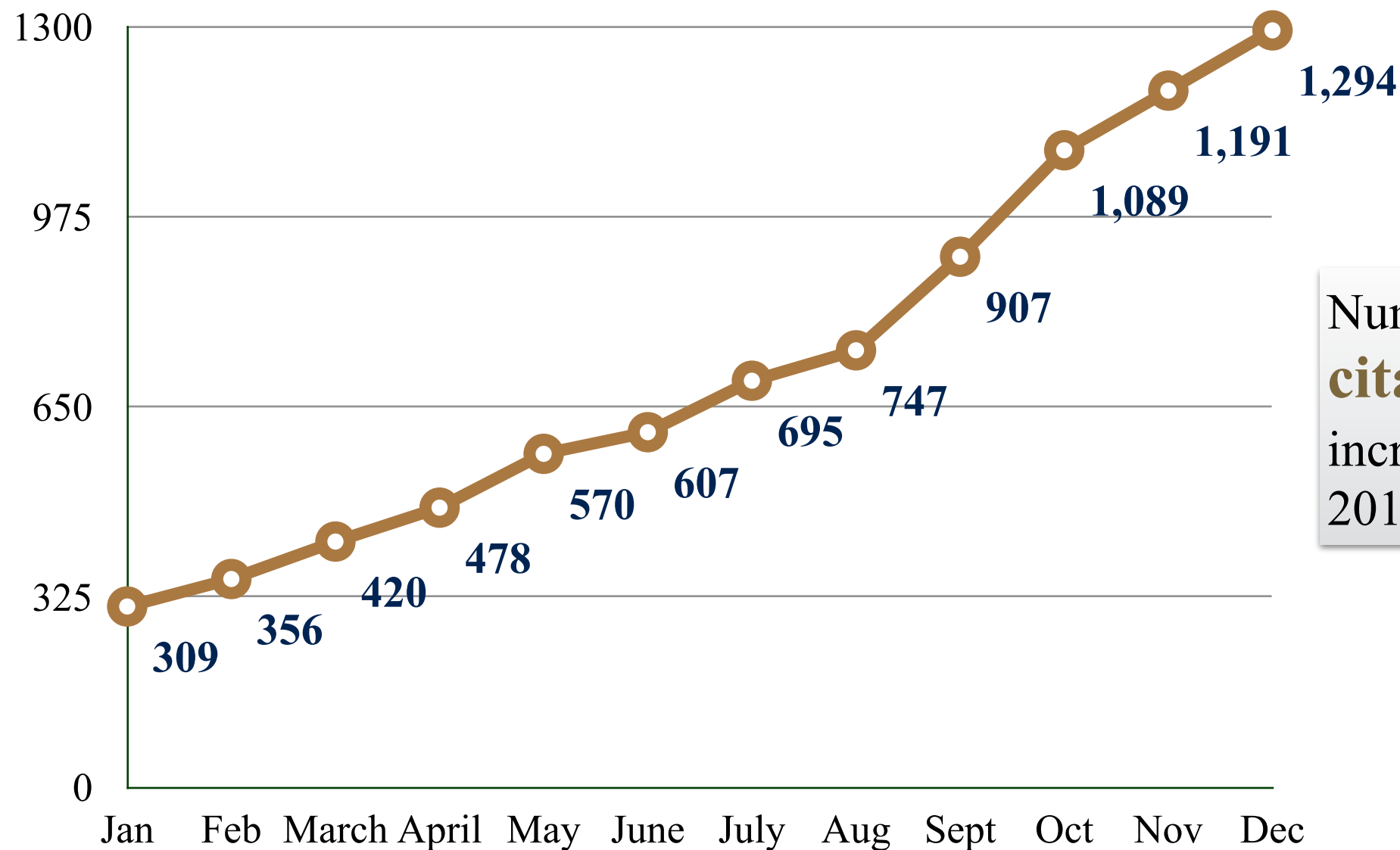

Corresponding authors of 628 articles published in 2016 come from **38 countries**, with **26%** of them from **USA**.

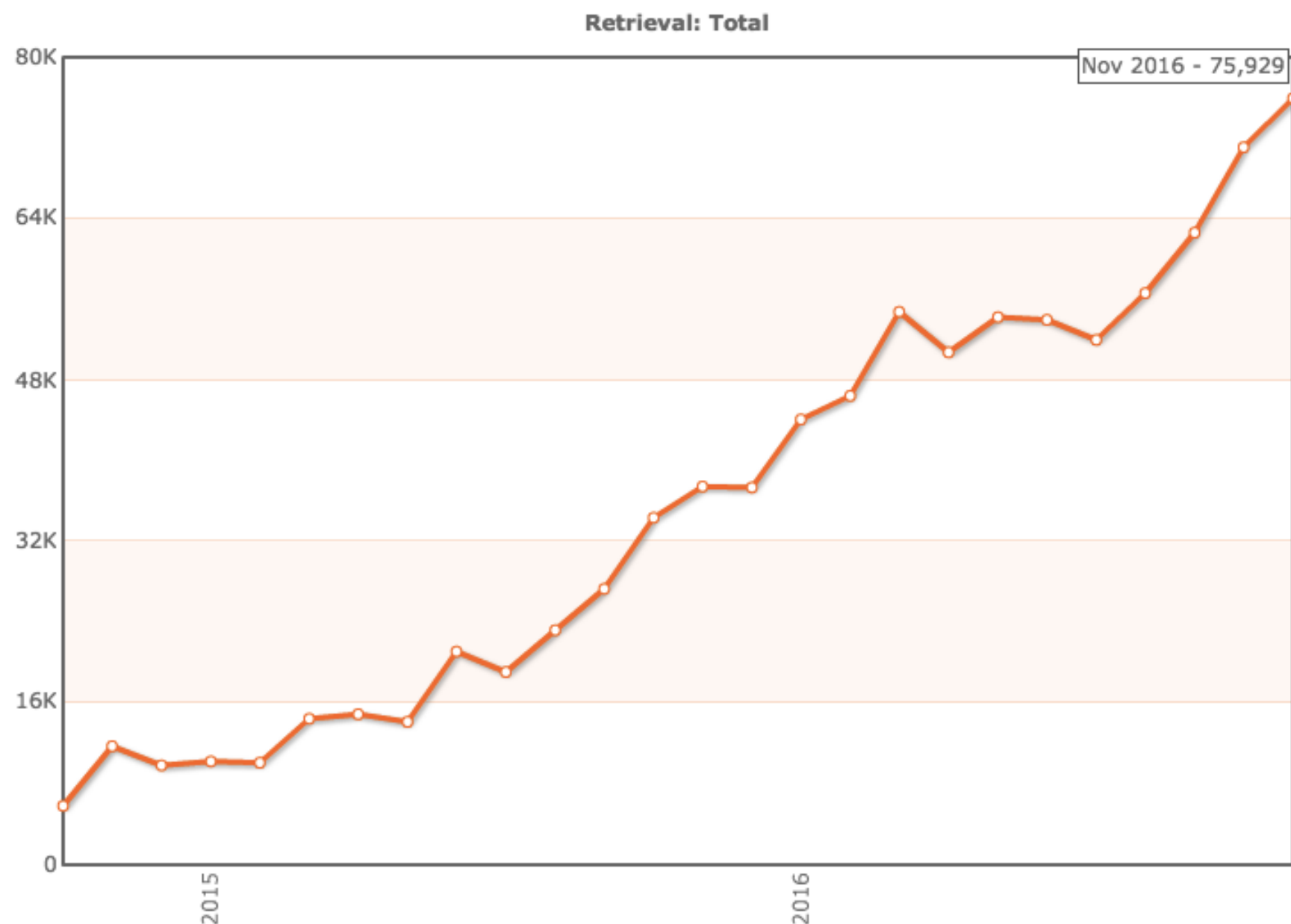
7. Citations in 2016 (results by month)

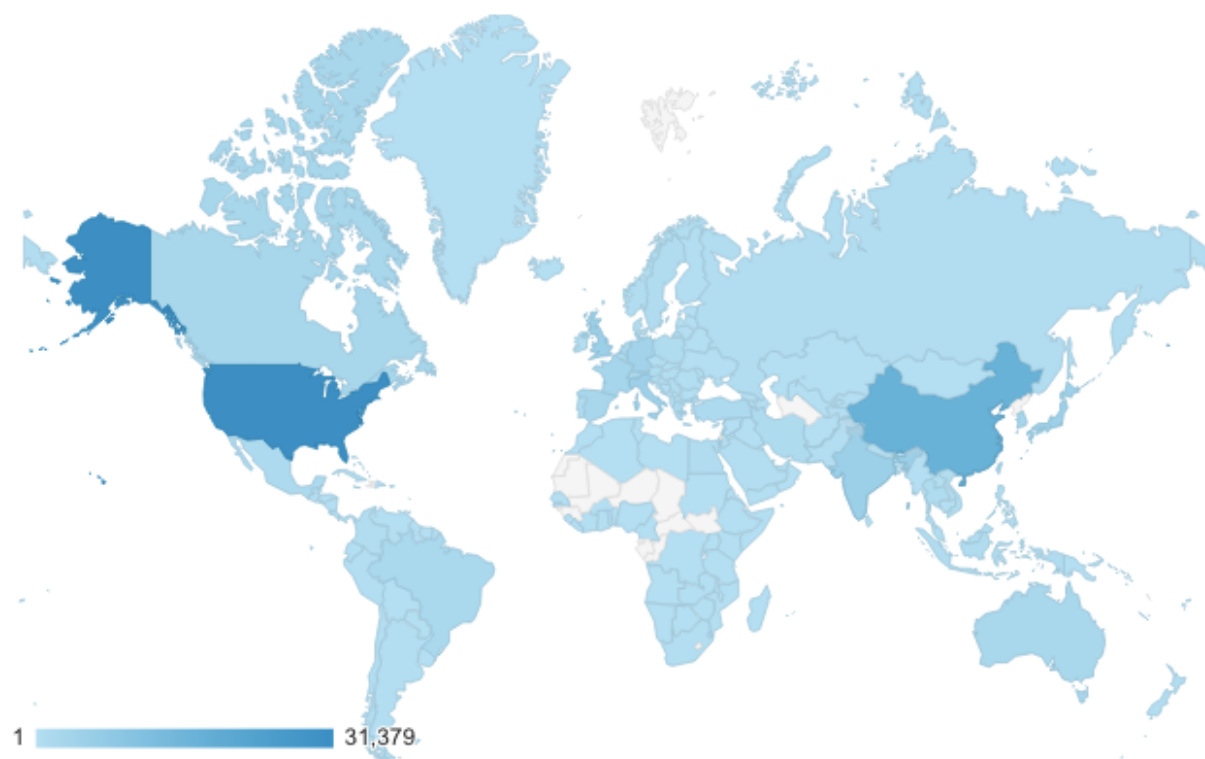
8. Monthly Retrievals in PubMed in 2016

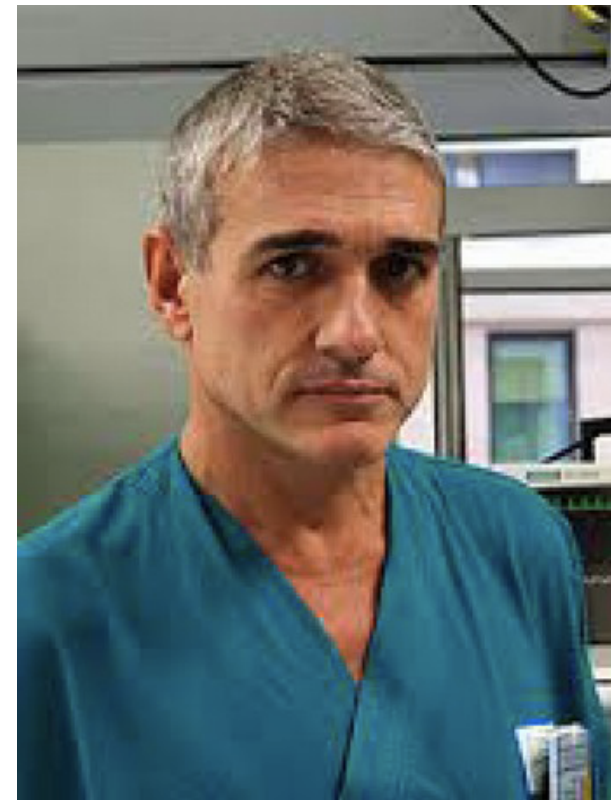

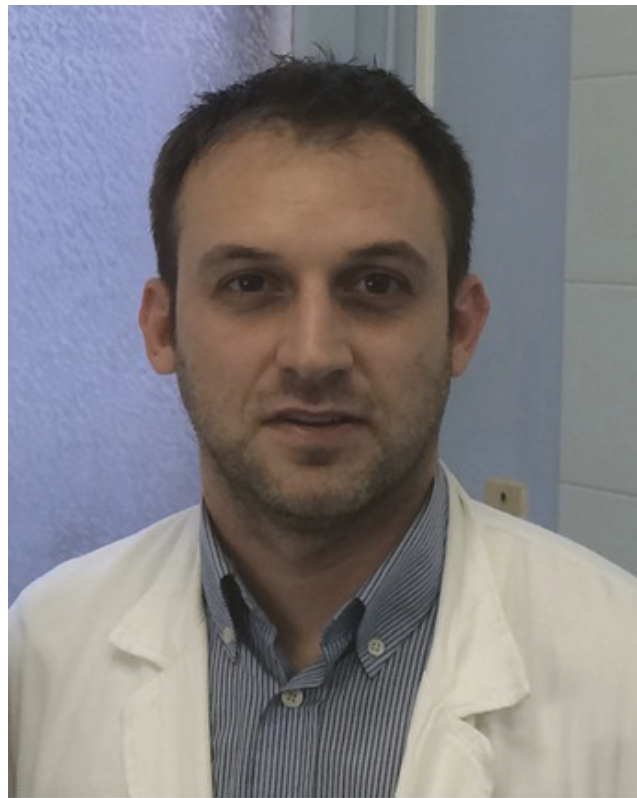
